2 year old camps: \$75/week
AM camps: \$89/week; July 4th week \$74/week
PM camps: \$89/week; July 4th week \$74/week
7-9 year old full day camp: \$175/week; July 4th week \$175/week includes transportation costs
Extended care: \$20/week. No charge for all day camps
AM and PM: Golf/Gymnastics camps: \$119/week
Full Day: Golf/Gymnastics/Dance camps: \$210/week

Registration and Payments

Registration begins Saturday, March 21st from 8am to noon at Encompass (1407 Boalch Avenue NW in North Bend). Please download and fill out a registration form for each child prior to registration (www.encompassnw.org). You may register for only one family other than your own on Saturday, March 21. Due to the possibility of long lines on registration day, numbers will be passed out to people in line and rooms will be opened in the building to keep you as comfortable as possible throughout the registration process. Weather permitting, our playground will be available for children to use while you register.

All camps require payment in full at the time of registration.

Teacher/Student Ratio

2 year olds: 12 children maximum in class. (1 teacher and 2 assistants)
3-4 year olds: 18 children maximum in class. (1 teacher and 2 assistants)
5-6 year olds: 18 children maximum in class. (1 teacher and 2 assistants)
7-9 year olds: 16 children maximum in class. (1 teacher and 2 assistants)
